Submitting Your Manuscript

How to submit: Please visit Manuscript Central at <https://mc.manuscriptcentral.com/rdc>. The author's submission page has a pull-down list of article types. Please select Type "**Conference Paper**" and special issue "**2018 Bordeaux Mortars Paper**".

Style & formatting: Please follow the guidelines found under the Manuscript Submissions tab on our website (<http://radiocarbon.webhost.uits.arizona.edu/node/10>).

Color figures: Online color is free. Color images in the print version will be billed at US \$320 +VAT each. Figures will be printed in black & white unless authors have paid color charges. Please indicate any print color figures when submitting via Manuscript Central.

Page charges: Papers up to the first 8 printed pages* are published free of charge. *This equates to approximately 4500 words (about 15 manuscript pages) and 4 figures.* Gratis online publication of supplementary materials (figures, tables, data, etc.) is available for all accepted papers.

*Authors will select Green or Gold access on the copyright form that is sent upon manuscript acceptance. If the Green open access model is chosen, authors will be billed US \$50 for any article pages after page 8 (so, a 10-page article would be billed \$100). Gold open access papers will be charged a flat fee of US \$1575, regardless of page length, and page charges will be waived.
